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Description:

This project required demolition of the existing dock piling, concrete capitals and transfer ramp. Once removed, new piling structures were installed including floating fenders, mooring structures, and barge restraint dolphins. A sectional steel transfer barge was assembled with a vehicle platform including stern and side berth transfer ramps. The floating structure is connected to shore via a 185-ft vehicle/pedestrian bridge. Upland work included vessel wastewater and potable water systems. The work required detailed planning and logistics to meet the short contract duration. Constructionaire completed the project under a 50/50 partnership agreement with Strider Construction Company.
